

Safeguarding Disabled Children – Working in the Margins

This is a 3 hour session for practitioners

What will the course cover?

There will be an update on the latest themes from research and learning from Serious Case Reviews in respect of Disabled Children.

Practitioners will be asked to consider a whole life approach to safeguarding disabled children

- Reflecting on their own practice with young children and their families now – how can this affect how safe they will be as adults in the future.

Considering a whole family approach to safeguarding

- Living with a Disabled child in the family – the needs of siblings and parents/carers.

Identify the strengths and challenges of multi-agency working

- Explore barriers to recognition of risks and the challenges in multi-agency practice.
