



## West Yorkshire Safeguarding Children Boards Train the Trainers Programme 2019

By the end of the course participants should be able to:

- Describe how adults learn and the different learning styles
- List different methods of delivery and evaluate the pros and cons of these
- Recognise different resources available to trainers and the pros and cons of these
- Identify techniques of how to handle difficult situations
- Demonstrate the skills required to deliver clear safeguarding messages
- Explain how and why the delivery of multi-agency safeguarding training is different to other forms of training delivery

This course is offered to those who are delivering, co-delivering or guest speaking on a Safeguarding Children’s Board multi-agency course or delivering safeguarding training internally to their own agency.

The course includes the opportunity to deliver a micro-teach in safeguarding in a safe and supporting environment.
