

Safeguarding Disabled Children – basic awareness

Identifying signs and indicators of harm and abuse for disabled children

- Make practitioners aware of the increased risks and how to identify potential signs and indicators of harm and abuse

Identify barriers to recognising and responding to safeguarding concerns for disabled children.

- Be able to identify attitudes and values which increase the risks and contribute to further disabling the child.

Recognise the needs of siblings and parents/carers

- Appreciate the increased support needed for siblings and carers

Strengths of multi-agency working

- More able to appreciate the challenges and strengths of multi-agency work to safeguard
Considering a whole-life approach
